Resurrection appearances to the Women: Mary Magdalene, Mary, the daughter of James, Joanna and Salome and certain others

Matthew 28:1 Now in the evening of the Sabbath, as it was twilight [on] the first of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to see the grave. [Sat eve]

Mark 16:9 And early on the first of the week he had risen and appeared first to Mary Magdalene from whom he had cast out seven demons. [summary]

John 20:1 Now on the first of the week, Mary Magdalene came in the early morning while it was dark to the tomb. And she saw the stone that it was taken away from the grave. [before sun rising]

John 20:11-17 Now Mary was standing by the grave and was crying. And as she cried, she looked into the grave.

¹² And she saw two angels in white who were sitting, one by his pillows and one at his feet, where the body of Jesus had been laid.

¹³ And they said to her, "Woman, why are you crying?" She said to them, "Because they have taken away my Lord and I do not know where they have put him."

¹⁴ She said this and she turned back and saw Jesus standing [there]. And she did not know that it was Jesus.

Jesus.

15 Jesus said to her, "Woman, why are you crying and whom do you seek?" Now she thought that he was the gardener and said to him, "My lord, if you have taken him, tell me where you have put him. I will go [and] take him away."

¹⁶ Jesus said to her, "Mary." And she turned around and said to him in Hebrew, "Rabbuli," which means Teacher.

¹⁷ Jesus said to her, "Do not touch me, for I have not yet ascended to my Father. But go to my brothers and tell them [that] I ascend to my Father and your Father, and [to] my God and your God."

Luke 24:1 Now on the first [day] of the week, at dawn while [it was] dark, they came to the tomb and brought the spices they had prepared, and there were with them other women. [all other women except Mary Magdalene]

Mark 16:2-7 And early on the first [day] of the week, they came to the tomb while the sun was rising.

- ³ And they were saying among themselves, "Who [will] roll the stone from the door of the tomb for us?"
- ⁴ And they looked [and] saw that the stone was rolled away, for it was very great.
- ⁵ And they entered the tomb and saw a young man who was sitting on the right [side] and wrapped around [him] was a white robe, and they were amazed.

⁶ And he said to them, "Do not be afraid. You seek Jesus the Nazarene who was crucified. He has risen. He is not here. Behold, the place where he was laid.

⁷ But go [and] tell his disciples and Peter that, behold, [he goes] before you to Galilee. There you will see him as he said to you." [1 angel inside the tomb]

Matthew 28:5-7 Now the angel answered and said to the women, "Do not fear, for I know that you seek Jesus who was crucified.

⁶ He is not here, for he has risen, as he said. Come, see the place in which our Lord was laid.

⁷ And go quickly [and] tell his disciples that he has risen from the dead, and *behold, [he goes] before you to Galilee. There you will see him. *Behold, I have told you." [same as above]

Luke 24:4-8 And it happened that while they were astonished about this, *behold, two men stood above them and their clothing was shining.

⁵ And they were in fear and bowed their faces to the ground. And they said to them, "Why do you seek the living with the dead?

⁶ He is not here. He has risen! Remember what he spoke to you while he was in Galilee

⁷ and he said that the Son of Man will be delivered into the hands of men [who are] sinners and would be crucified, and after three days would rise?" [two angels as the women were leaving]

Matthew 28:8- And they went away quickly from the grave with fear and with great joy and ran to tell his

disciples.

⁹ And behold, Jesus met up with them and said to them, "Peace to you." And they came near [and] clasped his feet and worshipped him.

Then Jesus said to them, "Do not fear! But go [and] tell my brothers that they should go to Galilee and

there they will see me."

Luke 24:9-10 And they returned from the grave and told all these [things] to the eleven and to the rest.

Now there was Mary Magdalene and Joanna and Mary the mother [daughter] of James and the rest who were with them, who had told the apostles. [summary]
