PHILIP'S TRAVELS

1. Philip becomes a deacon with six others (Acts 6:5).
2. Philip travels to “the city of Samaria,” where Simon the sorcerer is converted (Acts 8:4 ff.).
3. The road from Jerusalem to Gaza: Philip baptizes the Ethiopian eunuch (Acts 8:26 ff.).
4. “Found at Azotus,” Philip preaches from city to city until he reaches Caesarea (Acts 8:40).
5. Philip lives in Caesarea with his four virgin daughters, who are prophetesses. They are visited there by Paul (Acts 21:8 ff.).
